



Fees, charges and expenses

Membership

All members must be members of BSAC nationally and pay the appropriate national membership fee. In addition, members pay the following annual Branch Levy to the club.

Annual branch levy, all grades except honorary life members (from 1 April 2024)	£132	11 Oct 2023

The branch levy should be paid by Direct Debit. Members who have been a member continuously for the last 12 months, and new members signing up to a diver grade course (see below), may optionally pay by Direct Debit in monthly instalments of £11.

Diver grade courses

Training is provided free by our volunteer instructors, but we make a small charge to cover course materials and a contribution towards the instructors' expenses. Basic equipment hire for five months is included for Ocean Diver trainees.

Equipment hire

Hire of basic equipment for Ocean Diver trainees for the first five months is included in the cost of Ocean Diver training. Beyond the first five months, and for all qualified divers, the cost of equipment hire is shown in the following table.

Boat use

Charges for the use of Hornet are limited to a maximum of £200 per trip. There is no charge for days when Hornet is not launched, or, if kept on a mooring during the trip, does not leave the mooring.

Air fills and compressor use

Trips that use the compressor are expected to account, and pay, for the compressor usage at the end of the trip.

Try dives

A 20% discount on try dives is offered on group bookings of four or more from Scout, Guide and other community youth groups.

Expenses

Current expenses rates that will be paid by the club.

Instructor expenses

The basis for working out expenses rates payable for instructors is set out in the Club's Instructors' Expenses Policy, the present version of which was adopted by the committee on 11 May 2022. The table below details the current rates.

Towing

The cost of towing of the boat for trips must be covered by the trip and the club will not pay expenses for this. Where the boat is towed on behalf of the club (e.g. between winter and summer storage sites) the club will pay a towing allowance.

The basis for calculating the rate to be paid for towing the boat was agreed by the committee on 12 July 2023. The rate is calculated annually in April on the basis of a diesel vehicle having a fuel consumption of 20mpg and the cost of diesel in the West Midlands, as reported by the AA for March of that year. An allowance of 10p per mile for additional wear and tear is then added.

The current rate is shown below.

Item	Rate
Towing allowance	44.8p per mile.
